To approve the “proposal to renew police protection millage language” for the August 7, 2018 Election. The millage language to read as follows:

PENINSULA TOWNSHIP

PROPOSAL TO RENEW POLICE PROTECTION MILLAGE

This proposal reestablishes the 2/10ths of a mil police protection millage previously approved by the electors that expired after the December, 2017 levy. Specifically, the proposal renews and restores the .0002 mils previously rolled back by the Headlee Amendment.

Shall the limitation on the amount of ad valorem taxes which may be levied by the Township of Peninsula, Grand Traverse County, Michigan, against taxable property in the Township be increased by up to two-tenths (2/10ths) of a mil (\$.20 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of four (4) years, 2018 through 2021, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for police protection, and shall the Township levy such millage for this purpose? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage would raise an estimated \$140,405 for the Township when first levied in 2018.
