Traverse City. Weather permitting, this is Grand Traverse County Road Commission's updated road construction report as of September 8, 2017. This notice is prepared on information supplied by our contractor and staff. Please note: Pavement markings will begin on SUNDAY, September 10.

**Maple Terrace, Peninsula Township.**

\*DTE is continuing its relocation of a gas main.

**South Airport Road, Three Mile Road to Townline Road. East Bay Township. LANE CLOSURE.**

- \*Lane closure is scheduled for Monday, September 11, 2017.
- \*A gas line is being constructed for Costco.
- \*Flaggers will direct traffic for two-way traffic.
- \* Motorists should anticipate delays and plan accordingly.

**US-31 North to Acme/M-72 East to the Kalkaska County Line. Acme/Whitewater Township. LANE SHIFT/SHOULDER CLOSURE.**

- \*Crews will be removing high ridge materials from shoulders to improve drainage.
- \*Shoulders/Lane closures will occur during the week, alternating on both sides of the road.
- \*Traffic will be directed by flag control.

**M-113 by Railroad Tracks on east end of Village of Kingsley. ROAD CLOSURE.**

- \*Railroad agents are repairing the road and tracks.
- \*This portion of M-113 will be closed beginning Monday, September 11, 2017
- \*Work is scheduled to last eight (8) work days.

**Pavement Markings for School Zones. Various Locations.**

- \*Contractor will be marking pavements to designate school zones.
- \*Work is anticipated to begin on Sunday and continue throughout Tuesday.
- \*Motorists should not travel near wet paint which is designated by safety cones.

**GTCRC Maintenance Activities**

- \*Grading – surplus materials will be placed on seasonal roads. Whitewater and Acme Townships.
- \*Ditching - M-113 and Cedar Run Road
- \*Durapatching – Acme and Whitewater Townships
- \*Pothole patching - where requested
