

Consumers Energy is committed to providing safe and reliable energy to our Michigan customers. To ensure continued energy reliability to the Traverse City area, upgrades are planned including rebuilding of the high-voltage electric distribution line serving Peninsula Township. The work will be done along Center Road moving north through the neighborhoods and then continuing north of McKinley Road for about 1 mile along the current pole line.

To help avoid long-term outages, the high voltage distribution line will be rebuilt approximately 20 feet from the existing line, as staked. Once the new line is built and energized the old line will be removed. Construction is expected to be complete in the fall of 2018.

On or about Feb. 26, tree trimming and removal work will begin in this area and continue for several months, weather permitting. All trees and brush within 40 feet of the new line location will be cut, as well as any hazardous trees outside of the staked area and marked with blue paint. Trees marked with a blue dot will be trimmed while trees and brush marked with a blue X will be removed in accordance with the easements.

Customers living along the easement were mailed a letter in early February describing the project.
