

**PENINSULA TOWNSHIP  
CEMETERY-RELATED POLICIES  
EFFECTIVE: 01/01/2010**

**INTRODUCTION**

Three cemeteries currently are managed by Peninsula Township: Bohemian, Ogdensburg, and Peninsula. Both Bohemian and Ogdensburg have long waiting lists; unless either of these cemeteries is expanded, it is unlikely that demand for lots in them will change. Peninsula Cemetery is the newest and largest cemetery. It has a standard cemetery layout with lots marked at their corners with circular, in-ground, stainless steel plaques. These plaques are flush with the landscape and delineate the lot number and corner. Two special cemetery areas are found in Peninsula Cemetery—the green cemetery section and the pet cemetery section. There is a proposal for a memorial forest section as well as a columbarium, but neither has been delineated in Peninsula Cemetery to date.

**COSTS**

These prices are Per Lot, which is 6 x 12 or 6 x 6 as indicated below.

Resident versus Non-resident is defined as follows:

- **Resident**—a property owner, or registered voter of Peninsula Township.
- **Non-resident**—anyone who is not a property owner, or registered voter of Peninsula Township.
