

Volunteer at Mission Point Lighthouse

Volunteers are needed to do many things at the Lighthouse, so depending on your talents and interests, there may be a way for you to support the Lighthouse in some way:

Day Keepers ... While the Lighthouse is operated by people who stay in the building and run the gift shop and talk to visitors, they are required to stay weeks at a time and so get a day or two off during their time here. On those days, the Lighthouse is still open, and we need folks like you to come in to take over basic duties of operating the gift shop and taking tour money. Hours can be 10-2 or 2-6 or all day. A background check is required by Peninsula Township.

Gardeners ... the grounds need a lot of work, and we welcome your ideas and expertise!

Educators ... people who enjoy kids, nature, and history can combine their expertise to help plan outings and experiences for school and scout groups and/or lead such outings.

Builders and painters ... if you are good at working with your hands, then helping with little projects in and around the Lighthouse might be the things for you.

Historians ... if you have knowledge about antiques and artifacts from the early 1900's, we would welcome it to help set up displays, research pieces, and develop informational plaques and signs.
