Applicant

"Family day care home" means a private home in which 1 but less than 7 minor children are received for care and supervision for periods of less than 24 hours a day, unattended by a parent or legal guardian, except children related to an adult member of the family by blood, marriage or adoption. It includes a home that gives care to an unrelated child for more than four (4) weeks during a calendar year.

Section 6.2.2 Uses Permitted by Right:

- (7) <u>Family Day Care Homes and Group Day Care Homes</u>:
  - (a) Such uses shall be duly licensed by the State Department of Social Services.
  - (b) Fencing of outdoor play areas may be required should it be determined by the Zoning Administrator that conditions exist in the immediate vicinity which could be hazardous to the user children or that objectionable trespass could occur onto neighboring properties by the user children. The Zoning Administrator shall make such determination by contacting adjacent property owners by U.S. Mail and allowing a ten (10) day response time to receive comments from the neighbors regarding such probability.
  - (c) The Zoning Board of Appeals may, at any time, limit the hours of operation of a family day care home should they receive any written complaints regarding operating hours.

A "Family Day Care permit" shall be obtained from the Zoning Administrator. Such permit shall be revoked should the Family Day Care at any time not meet the above conditions. FURTHER, any permit shall become null and void after one (1) year from the date of granting such permit unless the Family Day Care has been established and operating.

Signs shall meet the Peninsula Township Zoning Ordinance as specified in Section 7.11.
