
## PENINSULA TOWNSHIP PURCHASE OF DEVELOPMENT RIGHTS ORDINANCE NO. 23, AMENDMENT #4

At a duly scheduled and noticed meeting of the Township Board of Peninsula Township, Grand Traverse County, Michigan, held at the Peninsula Township Hall on April 8, 2025, at 7:00 p.m., Township Board Member moved to adopt the following Ordinance, which was seconded by Township Board Member:  An Ordinance to amend the Purchase of Development Rights Ordinance #23 to include additional properties identified in the updated Agricultural Preservation Area map adopted at the March 12, 2025, Township Board Special Meeting at the recommendation oof the Peninsula Township Planning Commission.
PENINSULA TOWNSHIP, GRAND TRAVERSE COUNTY, MICHIGAN, ORDAINS:
SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE #23 AND AGRICULTURAL PRESERVATION AREA MAP. The Peninsula Township Board hereby amends the Agricultural Preservation Area Map included in Ordinance #23 as Appendix A to include the following additional properties identified more commonly via parcel numbers 11-226-002-00, 11-227-013-03, 11-226-023-00, 11-226-023-30, 11-236-913-00, and 11-225-006-00 and located north of Old Mission, east of Center Road, as within the Agricultural Preservation Area.
The amended Agricultural Preservation Area Map to be included in Ordinance #23 as Appendix A is attached as Exhibit A of this Ordinance.
SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY: The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and if any provision, section or part of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall only affect the particular provisions, section, or part involved in such decision and shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of such Ordinance, which shall continue in full force and effect.
<b>SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE:</b> This Ordinance shall become effective seven (7) days after its publication following final adoption or as required by law.
SECTION 4. REPEAL: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.  YEAS: NAYS: ABSENT/ABSTAIN:  While the second ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
