ORDINANCE No. 54 of 2019

EFFECTIVE: July 9, 2019 (pending approval at public hearing), TO BE
ENFORCEABLE 30 DAYS AFTER PUBLICATION.

PROHIBITION OF MARIHUANA ESTABLISHMENTS ORDINANCE

TITLE

AN ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO THE MICHIGAN REGULATION AND TAXATION OF MARIHUANA ACT, 2018 INITIATED LAW, 1, §6.1, MCL 333.27956, SUBSECTION 1, TO PROHIBIT MARIHUANA ESTABLISHMENTS WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF PENINSULA TOWNSHIP AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS, AND REPEALING ANY AND ALL ORDINANCES AND/OR RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

PENINSULA TOWNSHIP BOARD ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE

This ordinance shall be known and cited as the Peninsula Township Prohibition of Marihuana Establishments Ordinance.

SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this ordinance is to exercise Peninsula Township's authority pursuant to the Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act, MCL 333.27956, *et. seq.* ("Act") to prohibit the establishment and/or operation of any and all marihuana establishments, as defined by the Act, within Peninsula Township.

SECTION 3. ENABLING AUTHORITY

This ordinance is adopted pursuant to, and in accordance with, Section 6(1) of the Act adopted by the voters of the State of Michigan on Tuesday, November 6, 2018.

SECTION 4. MARIHUANA ESTABLISHMENTS PROHIBITED

It shall be unlawful to operate a marihuana establishment within the boundaries of Peninsula Township. The term "marihuana establishment" shall include, but not be

limited to:

- A. Marihuana microbusinesses;
- B. Marihuana retailers;
- C. Marihuana processors;
- D. Marihuana secure transporters;
- E. Marihuana safety compliance facilities;
- F. Marihuana growers (a person licensed to cultivate marihuana and sell or otherwise transfer marihuana to marihuana establishments);
- G. All marihuana-related businesses licensed by the state pursuant to the Act.

SECTION 5. VIOLATION; PENALTY

Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be responsible for a municipal civil infraction as defined in Public Act 12 of 1994, amending Public Act 236 of 1961, being Sections 600.101-600-9939, of Michigan Compiled Laws, and shall be subject to a fine of not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00). Each day this ordinance is violated shall constitute a separate violation and shall be subject to a fine.

Any violation of this ordinance shall also constitute a nuisance per se and the township shall have the right to seek abatement of the violation at law or in equity.

The township director of zoning and ordinance enforcement officer and any other person appointed by the township board to act as an agent of the township is authorized to issue a municipal civil citation directing alleged violators of this ordinance to appear in court.

SECTION 6. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING PROVISIONS

All resolutions, ordinances, or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.

SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY

If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the invalidity or unconstitutionality of such section, paragraph, clause, or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 8. PUBLICATION

This ordinance or summary thereof shall be published in the *Traverse City Record-Eagle* through general circulation within Peninsula Township within fourteen (14) days after adoption by the board of trustees.

SECTION 9. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect and be enforceable thirty (30) days after the date of publication as set forth in Section 8.
