PENINSULA TOWNSHIP PARK COMMERCIAL ACTIVITY REGULATION ORDINANCE ORDINANCE No. 7

An Ordinance to regulate commercial activity on Township property and to provide for permits therefor and to provide penalties for violation of the provisions of this Ordinance.

THE TOWNSHIP OF PENINSULA ORDAINS:

Section 1.0 NAME

This Ordinance shall be known and cited as the PENINSULA TOWNSHIP PARK COMMERCIAL ACTIVITY REGULATION ORDINANCE,

Section 2.0 COMMERCIAL ACTIVITY

No person, organization, legal entity of any type, or voluntary unincorporated organization shall conduct any business of a commercial nature whatsoever as defined herein in a township park without first obtaining a permit issued by the Township Board.

Section 3.0 DEFINITION

Conducting business of a commercial nature means the solicitation of services or the sale of any product to purchasers of the sale of any services for remuneration and shall include vending and peddling.

Section 4.0 APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

Application for a permit described in Section 2.0 hereof shall be made in writing to the Township Clerk on such form that may be provided by the Clerk. No such license shall be issued until the application is approved by the Township Board upon

a determination that the issuance of such permit shall not be detrimental to public health, safety or welfare.

Section 5.0 DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

Application for a permit shall be submitted at lease 48 hours prior to the time for which the permit is to be issued unless the Township Board shall otherwise for cause shown:

Section 6.0 DENIAL OF PERMIT

A permit may be denied if its issuance shall be likely to be a detriment to public health, safety or welfare in the opinion of the Township Board.

Section 7.0 PENALTIES

Any person who shall violate any provision of this

Ordinance in any particular, or who fails to comply with any of the regulatory measures or conditions of the Township Board adopted pursuant hereto, shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not to exceed \$500.00 or may be imprisoned not to exceed ninety (90) days or may be both fined and imprisoned in the descretion of the Court, and each day such violation continues shall be deemed a separate offense.

Section 8.0 EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after legal publication.
