South End Residents Focus Group: Fix, Keep, Aspire

FIX

- **Speeding on smaller roads (E Shore, Bluff Rd, Center)**
- Repair and widening of road shoulders
- Educational programs for visitors and residents on road sharing/awareness of non-motorized road users
- Additional signage
- Specific Locations
 - Peninsula Drive north of the light—insufficient pedestrian infrastructure
 - Intersection of Peninsula Dr and Center Rd—drivers leaving the Peninsula cut off turn lane
- Create new exit points from the Peninsula (College, E Front, Milliken Dr)
- Make people feel safe on the roads again—kids and elderly should have independence and mobility

KEEP

- Maintain views and trees (E Shore, Center, Peninsula)
- Boat Launch access point concerns
- Real estate and private property priorities
- Rural character of the Peninsula

ASPIRE

- One-ways on Park, Bluff, and E Shore
- **Non-motorized path running the length of the Peninsula**
- Tax structures and tolls to capture tourism dollars and fund non-motorized infrastructure
- Increased public access to the water on both sides of the Peninsula (may involve purchases)
